CAMP INFORMATION SHEET 2024

The following information will help ensure that you are well-prepared to enjoy the Cardigan Lacrosse Camp Experience.

CAMP: July 31 - August 4 Wednesday thru Sunday

Locks & Lockers: We will issue each player a lock and locker. Since there are no locks on your room doors, you must keep your valuables, including sticks, in your locked lockers. Do not bring unnecessary valuables to camp.

CAMP STORE: The camp will operate a store and snack concession. You may wish to bring along money to purchase equipment, drinks, pizza, and/or snacks. \$50 to \$100 for incidentals may be sufficient. The store operates a bank in which you may leave money for safekeeping. Credit Cards are not accepted/cash only or checks accepted for placing money into the camp bank or purchasing camp T-Shirt.

TRAVEL DIRECTIONS to The Cardigan Mountain School is in Canaan, NH, which you can reach by taking exit 17 off I-89 and traveling east on Route 4 through Enfield to the town of Canaan. Take a left at the only traffic light in Canaan and follow the CMLC signs to school.
